 64 to 71 score.
- Chris Olson/James Rose defeated Wayne Nakama and Bob Henderson. This was the closest match of the day. The match was tied going into the 18th hole when James Rose finished with a birdie putt of at least 25 feet to close out the match with a net score of 65 versus a 67.
