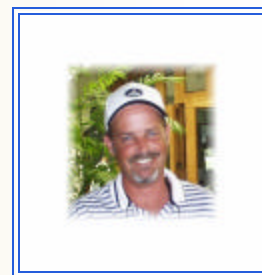

# Primm Valley Resort & Casino Information

## General Information and direction from Las Vegas McCarran Airport:

**Primm Valley Resort & Casino** is one of three casino resorts located at the Nevada-California border. The other resorts are **Buffalo Bills & Whiskey Pete's**. All three resort are owned and operated by the **MGM Mirage Group**. **The Primm Valley Resort complex is located approximately 40 miles south of Las Vegas McCarran International Airport on Nevada-California Interstate 15. By car, it takes approximately 35 minutes from the Las Vegas strip to the three resorts.** Whether you're a history buff or a gangster guru, you won't want to miss Primm's Bonnie & Clyde Collections. Get up close and personal with the infamous couple as you explore their getaway car and more notorious memorabilia includ-



ing the bullet-riddled shirt Clyde died in. You'll also get a glimpse of the restored Dutch Schultz-Al Capone gangster car. This intriguing display is located in the hallway adjacent to the Resort's Main Cashier Cage. On the other side of the display is the Resort's exclusive indoor Fashion Outlet, where over 100 designer stores await you and your loved ones for some *serious* shopping. This fabulous Fashion Outlet includes such world-class designers as Last Call from Neiman-Marcus, Off Sax Fifth Avenue, Calvin Klein, Perry Ellis, Donna Karan Company Store, Tommy Bahama, Nautica, Williams-Sonoma, Jhane Barnes, and Ashworth Golf, just to name a few.

## Restaurants & Fine Dining at the resorts:

**Primm's Gallery Café Coffee Shop** located next to the hotel lobby is open 24 hours a day serving all American breakfast, lunch and dinners. For breakfast, you can dine on Ron Nestor's favorite, **Steak & Eggs** breakfast deal for merely \$4.99 or choose Victor's quick \$1.99 **"Jackpot Special"** Breakfast. For lunch, we recommend that you take the free tram from

Primm Valley to Buffalo Bill's and enjoy many fast-food restaurants located there, such as Panda Express (Chinese), La Salsa (Mexican) and McDonald's .



If you're planning to stay at the resort for dinner, the best restaurant at the three resorts is the **"Silver Spur Steakhouse"** located at **Whisky Pete's** Resort where you can choose reasonably priced entrees from delicious Prime rib, USDA Prime grade steak dinner or seafood fares and pasta dishes.

**Family Entertainment:** For those daring souls, try the "Desperado" roller coaster at Buffalo Bills. Desperado is one of the tallest and fastest roller coasters in America, at the max speed of 90 MPH. You can also opt for Buffalo Bill's other adventures-like the gravity defying Turbo Drop, Maxflight 2002 Virtual Roller coaster, a thrilling new 3-D ride experience and the wet and wild Adventure Canyon Log Flame.

**Casino & Other gaming area:** Primm Resorts has over 33 table games, featuring favorite gambling games such as Black Jack, Pai Gow Poker, Let it Ride, Caribbean Stud Poker, Mini-Baccarat..Etc You can also try your luck at Primm 's slot-machines. From the generous rolling fairways and sparkling water accents of the Lake Course to the stunning beauty, narrow fairways and challenging natural terrain of the Desert Course, a great golf game is just a swing away.

Primm Valley Golf Courses are located 4 1/2 miles South of the Resorts Complex off Interstate 15 at Yates Well Road. You can reach the golf course by private car or arrange a pick up in advance via the resort's Complimentary Shuttle Service.

On Thursday, you can drop your golf bag for overnight storage at the course instead of hauling it back to your room. The course can store your clubs until after your final round on Saturday.

The course will provide you with tees and a yardage guide before you tee off on each round. Unlimited Range balls are complimentary on tournament days. Primm Valley has one of the best all grass practice facilities in the U.S., with end-to-end hitting areas that can accommodate up to 80 persons at the same time. A separate short game area (Including sand traps) is available to knock the rust off your game before you tee off.

During the round, you can purchase your favorite beverages and spirits from one of the beverage carts or stop by at the clubhouse during the round. The resort will provide you with one bottled water per person with refill stations located through out the courses. Keep in mind that June is the beginning of the summer season in Vegas. Please drink plenty of liquids to avoid dehydration. Each players should bring a bottle of strong sun block and lip balm.

Arrive at the Primm Resort and Casino at your leisure. Room Check-in is done on an individual basis in the Primm Valley Resort, anytime after 3:00pm.

## Bag Check-In and Storage at Primm Valley Golf Course

It is strongly recommended that you leave your clubs for overnight storage at the course. Primm's professional staff will be able to pre-load your golf bag on the golf cart according to the designated starting hole listed on the starting sheets (Pages 4-6). For those of you that arrive late, please look for your cart in the designated area on the morning of the tournament round.

## 6:00-9:00P.M. Welcome Cocktail Party

ALSRI Golf Club President, Steven Klotz, will host a reception party in a Suite @ Primm Valley (**Room 4567**) reserved for our group from **6:00—9:00P.M.** Please come join us for beer, wine, soft drinks, delicious appetizers and a chance to meet some of the other tournament participants.

**Meals:** Except for the banquet dinner on Saturday night, you are on your own for the four days. Coffee shops are located at all the Resort Hotels, and are open 24 hours. Some very nice restaurants are located both at **Primm Valley** Resort & Casino Hotel as well as **Whiskey Pete's** and **Buffalo Bills**. One of the player's favorites is the **Silver Spur** at Whiskey Pete's. Reservations are suggested for Thursday & Friday Nights when a number of us undoubtedly will be there! Advance reservations can be made by calling 1-800-FUNSTOP and asking for the **Silver Spur Steak House**, after 5 P.M. and up to seven days in advance. Evening Entertainment can be found at Primm if you look really hard...just kidding...Have fun, and remember to leave a **wake-up call** for the next day's golf!

## Friday, June 24th, 2005:

Breakfast on your own. Primm's coffee shop is open 24 hours a day but service can get slow with the heavy morning crowd, so get there early. McDonald's is located outside the hotel. Starbuck' Coffee has a store inside the convenience center adjacent to the Chevron Station next to the Freeway.

## **Primm's Driving Range will be open at 6:30A.M.**

**SHOT GUN start at 7:15 A.M.** Please be ready at your cart no later than 7:05 AM. Men play from the Blue Tee Marker. Ladies use Green Tee. Long Drive hole is # 8 (Men & Ladies). Ball must be in fairway. Closest to Pin Contests are on Holes # 4 and # 15, Closest-to-the Pin markers are for both Men and Ladies combined!

For those of you who have not played the **Desert Course**, a

word of caution that will help your play: This is a **"Position"** golf course...*consider playing the course just a bit conservatively.* After play, sign your scorecards and turn them in to a member of the Tournament Committee and/or Primm's tournament staff inside the Bar area of the Golf Shop at the course. (**Tournament Committee Members** are: **Victor Vannukul, Larry Taylor, Tim Baldwin, Howard Wu and Steven Klotz**). All decisions on tournament play will be made by the Committee, and their ruling is final.

Of course, the evening is yours to decide....Go into Las Vegas for dinner, shopping, gambling...If you don't want to travel the 45 mi, you can also eat here, go to the Fashion Outlet (over 100 stores), or try your luck at any of the Resort casinos!

## Saturday, June 25th, 2005:

Breakfast on your own.

## **Primm's Driving Range will be open at 6:30A.M.**

**SHOT GUN start at 7:15 A.M. We will play on the Lake Course.** This golf course also plays fast...the ball will run. More open than its' sister course, let it all hang out off the tee here. Get it close on the greens, though...these babies are huge. (And usually quick!) Another word of advice for both courses...everything has a tendency to break and be faster toward the freeway...take notice that both courses are built on the side of a large sloping hill. Play the ball down and keep up with the provisional, thanks. Long Drive hole is on Number 11. Same rules apply, Closest to Pin Contest will be on #. 6 and #17. Sign your scorecards after play and turn them in again to the Bar area of the Golf Shop.

**6 P.M. Banquet Awards Dinner at Banquet Room in the Primm Conference Center (Located down the hall, to the right of the Main Cashier).**

Alcoholic Beverages on your own. Dinner is served Buffet style.

Awards and Prizes ceremony immediately after dinner. Evening entertainment on your own.

## Sunday, June 26th, 2005:

Check-out time is 12 P.M. Make sure that you gather all belongings before check-out.. Have a safe trip home....**See you all next Year!!**
