SURVIVOR CUP UPDATE 11/20/2022

What a wonderful day it was on Monday October 24, 2022, at Harding Golf Course at beautiful Griffith Park in Los Angeles, California. ALSRI Golf Club's October Tournament and the Survivor Cup Team event was starting early in the morning in a nice clear day that reached around 70 degrees. Meanwhile, I was stuck halfway across the country working and missing the last change to qualify for the Tournament of Champions. No chance to place my name in that other trophy this year. But another thing I was missing out on was all the excitement of the Survivor Cup Competition. I missed out on the emotions in the faces of the losers and the winners. I missed out in the comments that were said after the tournament. I missed out on all the trash talking before and after the tournament. Did anyone throw any punches to anyone? Did any teams break up for good? I missed out on all the dirty looks. Missed out on all the middle fingers. The F words.

So, to write this article, I did not have a lot to go on. I am improvising with hearsay (mostly made up), in addition to the score cards. In my previous article, I had picked the winners of each of the four matches. I got three of four right. Picking previous champions was the right choice. Picking the guys from my regular foursome was the wrong choice. I guess I won't bet against a two-time Survivor Cup Winner Victor Vannukul again. So here are how the four matches unfolded:

(8) Samuel Klotz / George Murphy WON over (1) Dennis Murakami / Bryan Inoue 5 and 4.

The number one team gets crushed by the number eight team 5 and 4. Samuel and George struck on the first hole and pressed and pressed and pressed and did not let up. They were up three by the ninth hole and up five by the 14th hole. Dennis did not bring his A game while George and Samuel took turns winning holes. It was extremely hard to overcome two strokes George had on four holes against Dennis.

(2) Mike Yi / Bernard Penafuerte WON over (7) Chris Olson / Ed Chavez 4 and 2.

This match was even through the 7th hole. But Mike and Bernard started pulling away winning the next two to be up two at the turn. Ultimately, Chris and Ed were unable to overcome the five net birdies by Mike and Bernard who ended up four up on the 16th hole.

(6) Victor Vannukul / Vince Tran WON over (3) Young Kang / Ken Choi 4 and 2.

Young and Ken stuck first on the 3rd hole and were one up until the fifth hole where Victor and Vince tied and then won three more holes to be up three after nine. Victor and Vince did not let up and by the 16th hole they were up four. Victor's crazy good putting is what the other players in the group mentioned multiple times. Making 20+ footers with huge downhill breaks a couple of times broke Young and Ken's spirit. Vince's three net birdies also helped solidify their team play.

(4) Larry Salas / Bill Fetner WON over (5) Donald Toda / Larry Taylor 1 UP

This was the closest match of the four. Larry and Bill were up two on the front nine. They expanded the lead to three through the 13th hole. But Larry and Donald came back on the 14th and 15th to only be down by one. But ultimately, Larry and Bill held on the next three holes and won. Larry and Bill showed a perfect example of taking turns saving holes for the team.

My predictions for the next matches:

Larry Salas / Bill Fetner vs Samuel Klotz / George Murphy

Both teams have won this event in the past (twice by Samuel and George). Both teams have players that complement each other's game well. Samuel and George crushed their last competition 5 and 4 (the largest gap of any matches). But no one can discount Larry and Bill who are former Survivor Cup Champions and were in the finals in 2019. But at the end, I am choosing George and Samuel to win due to the format of the next event. Here, there is individual match ups plus team match. With George's high handicap, I cannot think that Bill can overcome all those strokes. Larry will have to beat Samuel by a significant margin to overcome the deficit.

Mike Yi / Bernard Penafuerte vs Victor Vannukul / Vince Tran

Both teams beat their competition 4 and 2. Both teams have players that have won the Survivor Cup. Former Survivor Cup Champion, Bernard has declared his team the 2022 Survivor Cup Champions (maybe I read the text wrong). He feels that his team's engine is firing in all 12 cylinders. Meanwhile, his partner, Mike, is sizing up the competition. Mike has been playing a lot of golf with Victor and has been asking Bernard to tone down his predictions on winning it all. That prediction is giving Victor a lot of motivation to get ready for the match. I had a wonderful experience of playing with Victor and Vince on November 14th. I noticed Victor's 170-yard drives were about 40 yards longer than my 180-yard drives. And they were hitting the fairways consistently. I was impressed with Victor's birdie in the first hole and an eagle a few holes later. Bernard's prediction is definitely fueling Victor's drive to play well in the next tournament. And I cannot forget to mention my former partner, Vince. Vince also played well that day. His drives were long, and he was relaxed. So, who do I choose to win this match? I am not betting against Victor again. Victor is an exceptional, focused player who is able to elevate his game during big moments. Mike is currently playing well so he may get ahead of Vince by a few holes, but Victor may take Bernard to school this time around (Victor has taken Bernard's prediction very personally). So, I predict a win by Love and Thunder (AKA Victor and Vince).

USGA Team Play Rules 24.2 (Modified for ALSRI' Survivor Cup Competition)

- 1 Team of two players play in two competitions; two individual match plays and one 2 person team play
- 2 A Player of each team play against each other in the match play format (**Match 1**)
- 3 B Player of each team play against each other in the match play format (**Match 2**)
- 4 Two players team (each side) play against the two players of the opposing team (**Match 3**)
- 5 Each match is worth two points. Tie match worth one point. There is six(6) points maximum for each team.
- 6 Players' index is limited to 80% of the course index using the current low index of players
- 7 **Match play** is a form of play where a player or team of two players play directly against another player in the opposing team or against the other two players team. You win a hole by completing it in the fewest number of NET strokes, you tie a hole (aka as "halved") when you and your opponent complete the hole in the same number of NET strokes. holes to be played.
- 8 You win a match when you are winning by more holes than remaining holes.
- 9 Since this competition is run in conjunction with a regular ALSRI Tournament, you may concede a stroke, a hole, or even the match to each other but, each player must holed out each hole for all 18 holes.
- 10 Advice to other team member is allowed in Match Play.
- 11 Please use the scorecard provided by ALSRI's Survivor Cup Committee for this match.

Tournament Rule / Scoring Reminders:

- **Bunkers are in play - If a ball lands in a footprint in a bunker, players may place a ball in the bunker within 6 inches of where the ball settled; the ground may be smoothed prior to placement of the ball. No penalty.**
- **For scoring purposes, double par is the maximum score to be recorded on a hole. Once you've reached double par, pick up your ball and record your score.**
