Right on Aliso Creek and Driving uphill to Glenwood Dr. LEFT on Glenwood and right on Golf Club Drive. (This is a scenic route—more tricky)

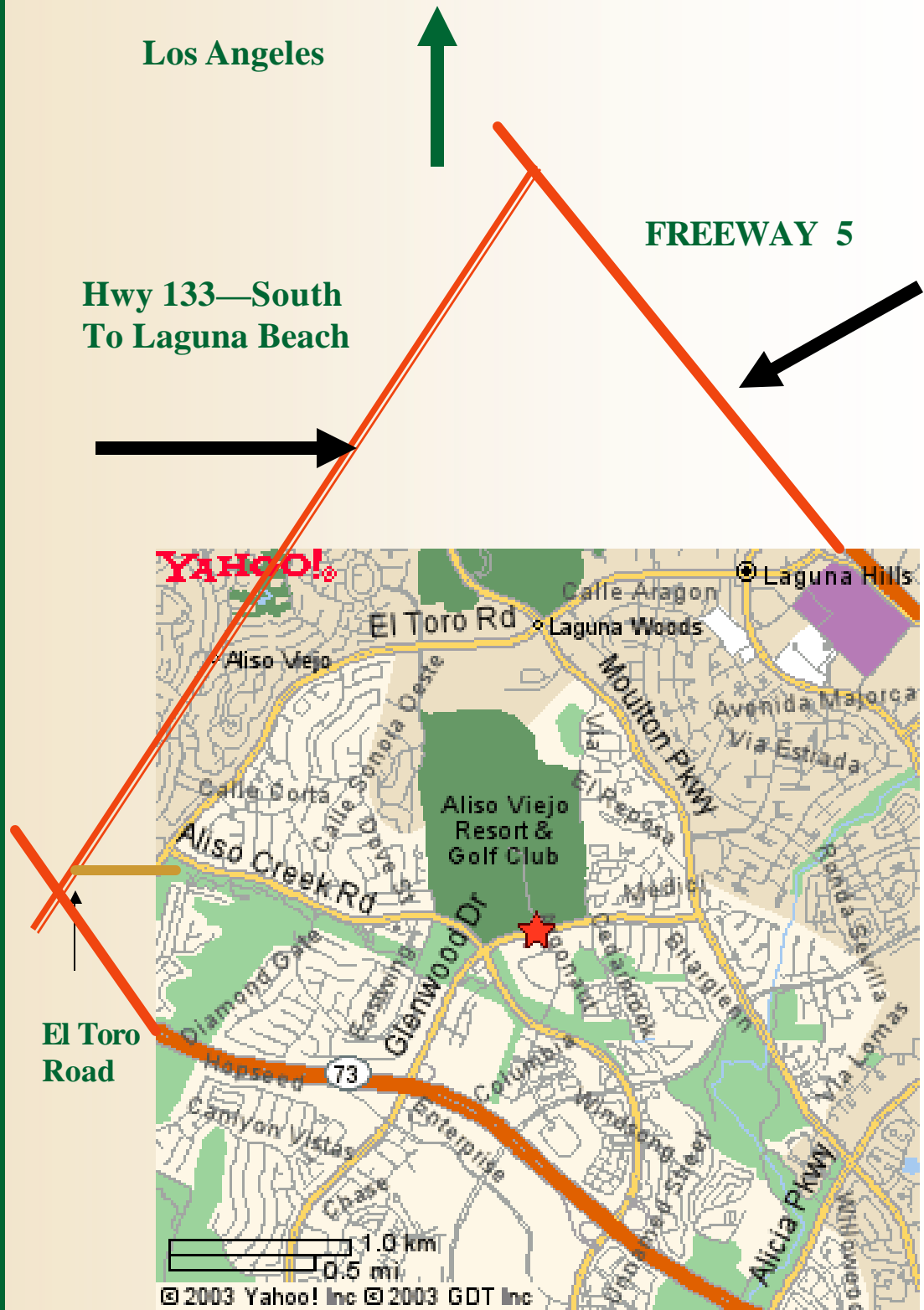
