#### **SURVIVOR CUP UPDATE 01/30/2023**

# **Tournament Rule / Scoring Reminders:**

- Bunkers are in play If a ball lands in a footprint in a bunker, players may place a ball in the bunker within 6 inches of where the ball settled; the ground may be smoothed prior to placement of the ball. No penalty.
- For scoring purposes, double par is the maximum score to be recorded on a hole. Once you've reached double par, pick up your ball and record your score.
- For those who are interested, we offer a Gross and Net Skin Game as part of the ALSRI tournaments. Entry fees are \$10 for the Gross game and \$5 for the Net game. See Bryan Inoue if you wish to participate in one or both of the games.
