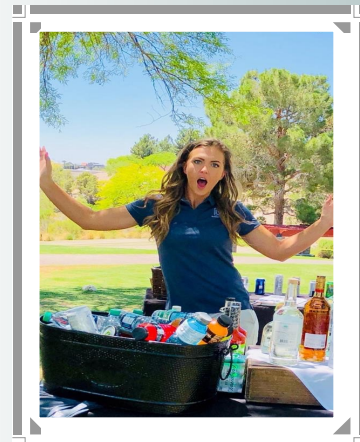

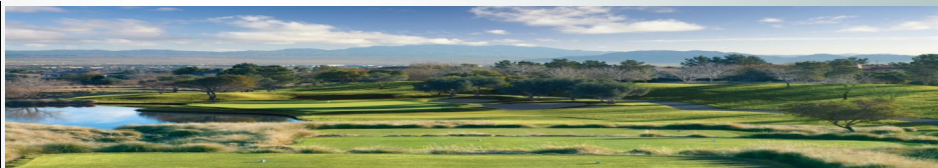

Tournament Players Club Las Vegas is "desert elegance" on display. From the stunning backdrop of Red Rock Canyon to the rugged natural landscape, TPC Las Vegas golf course (formerly known as TPC Canyons) offers a test to the most seasoned of golfers. This is the premier PGA TOUR facility in Las Vegas making it a destination for celebrities and PGA TOUR players alike. It's no wonder the golf course has been heralded by Golf Digest as one of the "Best Places to Play."

The Bobby Weed and Raymond Floyd design is a par 71, 7,063-yard golf course that will test your skills while dazzling you with views of the surrounding mountains, canyons and the famed Las Vegas skyline. Your shot making ability is put to the test early in your round on the par-3 second hole (appropriately named "Canyon"). You will need to carry your tee shot almost 200 yards from the tips to an island-like green in the middle of the desert.

E-5 Alternative to Stroke and Distance for Lost Ball or Ball Out of Bounds

Purpose. *When a provisional ball has not been played, significant issues with pace of play can result for a player needing to take stroke-and-distance relief for a ball that is out of bounds or cannot be found. The purpose of this Local Rule is to allow a Committee to provide an extra relief option that allows a player to play on without returning to the location of the previous stroke.*

The Local Rule is appropriate for general play where golfers are playing casual rounds or playing their own competitions. The Local Rule is not appropriate for competitions limited to highly skilled players (that is, professional competitions and elite amateur competitions). For guidance on when and how this Local Rule may be used in order for scores to be submitted for handicapping purposes, consult the rules or recommendations contained within the Handicap System operating in the local jurisdiction.

Where a Committee has introduced such a Local Rule for general play, and removes it for competitions, it should ensure that all players are aware of this before play begins.

A Committee may introduce such a Local Rule for all play on the course or only for one or two specific holes where it may be especially useful (for example, where players are unable to see the landing area and therefore may not know whether or not to play a provisional ball).

This option allows the player to drop in a large area between the point where the ball is estimated to have come to rest or gone out of bounds and the edge of the fairway of the hole being played that is not nearer the hole.

The player gets two penalty strokes when using this relief option. This means that the relief is comparable to what could have been achieved if the player had taken stroke-and-distance relief.

This Local Rule cannot be used for an unplayable ball, or for a ball that is known or virtually certain to be in a penalty area.

If a provisional ball is played and neither the original ball nor the provisional ball can be found, then the Local Rule may be applied for the provisional

Players without established index, their index will be based on either prior year adjusted scores or index computed under Calloway system.

Friends, Family and Guests Golfers:

We will compute all Friends, Family and Guests golfers either by using prior ALSRIWEST tournament scores or Calloway Handicapping System (First year participants) unless they can demonstrated that they have established USGA index from his/her own club. The tournament committee reserves the right to adjust the index of players who don't have an established USGA index. Your final designated competing flight could be different from the designated flight given to you at the beginning of the tournament.

Closest to Pin Contest are on all par 3s, Closest-to-the Pin markers are for both Men and Ladies combined!

After play, sign your scorecards and turn them in to a member of the Tournament Committee and/or TPC Summerlin's tournament staff inside the Golf Shop at the course. **(Tournament Committee Members are as follows: Victor Vannukul, Larry Taylor and Mike Yi).** All decisions on tournament play will be by Committee and their ruling is final.

All Men & Seniors with index less than 18.0 play from the White Tee Marker. Seniors, with over 18.0 index, have an option to play from the Gold Tee. Ladies use Red Tee. Closest to Pin Contest are on all par 3s. Closest-to-the Pin markers are for both Men and Ladies combined!
