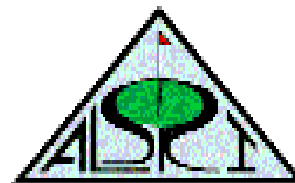

Recently, several members of the ALSRI Golf Club participated in a Golf Tournament held at Cypress GC. It was the Ted Tanouye Memorial Golf Tournament, and the tournament organizers included two members of our club. Ron Yamada was instrumental in getting the tournament off the ground, and served as Master of Ceremonies, and Bryan Inoue served as a member of the tournament committee. The tournament's fundraising efforts sought to erect a Memorial to Mr. Tanouye, a Congressional Medal of Honor recipient from WWII. Mr. Tanouye grew up in Torrance, CA.

The tournament format was a 4 person scramble, with the final score determined by low net, after tournament organizer's selected a blind draw of the handicap holes. Team ALSRI, consisting of Howard Wu, Tim Baldwin, Bernard Penafuerte, and Larry Taylor were participating as an all ALSRI entry. Also playing in separate groups were Bryan Inoue, John Fawaz, and Ron Yamada.

Team ALSRI got off to a blazing start, by making birdies on 4 of the first 6 holes. Spurred initially by Wu and Taylor's hot play, the shotmaking spread through the rest of the team. Tim Baldwin began to fire laser accurate short irons into the greens, and Bernard contributed a hot putter during the later stages of the round. The team finished at 9 under par 62, and missed the playoff for first place by a single stroke.

Afterwards, each member of the team remarked as to how much fun the tournament was, especially the scramble format. It reminded us of the early days of ALSRI, when our friend, the late Robert Maggio, would dominate the two person scramble events we would put on. The ALSRI Challenge Corner would like to thank Ron, Bryan, and the tournament committee for a well run event, that was very enjoyable to participate in.

Final Survivor's Cup Results

When you're hot, you're hot and when you're not, you're not. It sounds pretty trite, but it usually applies to most sports' championships. And it applied to the Survivor's Cup this year.

Thirty-six players (18 teams) set-out to win this year's Survivor's Cup. When the smoke cleared, when the dust settled, when the chips were down, when it was all over but the crying and whatever clichés you want to throw in there, it was the hottest team, at the end, that won.

Bob Sackett (no nepotism intended), and Chuck Fullington were indeed the hottest team the last two rounds of the Survivor's Cup. With the match play format of the final round they beat Bill Kim and Dan Hoshi by an 8 hole margin. In a typical match play format they would have won 6 and 4 (six hole lead with 4 holes to play). I had disdained the use of match play in the earlier rounds, because I didn't think it was fair to eliminate a team that perhaps played second best to the hottest team. The two teams vying for 3^d place, decided to split the 3rd and 4th place prizes, due to scheduling conflicts.

The hottest team in the first round was Jim Judd and Rich Brawley. With their stratospheric handicap they finished eleven strokes ahead of the eventual winners and nine strokes better than the eventual second place finishers. The hottest team in the second round was Kim and Hoshi. They appeared to be the favor-

ite at that time. Then things began to lean the Champs' way at the third round when they beat the second place team by 6 strokes.

The handicaps of the two finalist teams dropped like proverbial rocks. At Los Serranos in May, their handicaps were: B. Sackett-26, Fullington-24, Kim-23 and Hoshi-31. At San Dimas Canyon their handicaps were 19, 18, 18 and 22 respectively.

The prize winners each received a sleeve of ALSRI Logo balls and gift certificates to Golfsmiths.

The actual scores of the finalists at San Dimas Canyon were:

B. Sackett (92), C. Fullington (94), B. Kim (90) and D. Hoshi (122).

Congratulations to these two fine teams that have exemplified the Survivor's Cup spirit that I had hoped would prevail.

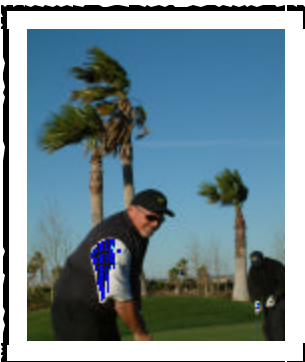

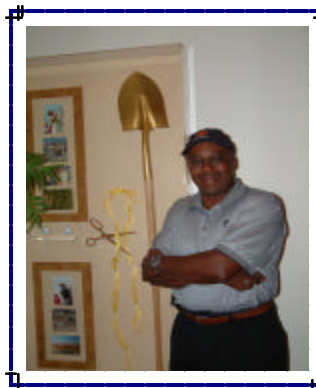
